Administrators should be chosen with respect to their (a) competence, (b) time, and (c) trustworthiness. However, there is a need of a set of rules for the election of administrators and criteria on different levels. These rules should be called "Fripost involvement policy", and Stefan will draft this document.

Gateway systems is a way so allow people that are not fully trustworthy to contribute. The question is whether there is an need for a complicated system for this. The concept is quite close to that of supplying patches.

A Git-server is set up, git.fripost.org, with push access via ssh-key. A task list based on Git and org-mode markup is created through the git.fripost.org:fripost-admin repository.

The relevant tasks is more about searching for solutions, so details about access, etc. can wait a more detailed overview of the tasks and their needs.
